## The Boardwalk

Officially know as Atlantic Avenue, dates to 1902.  
Several oceanfront hotel owners got together and constructed a wooden walkway for the convenience of their guests. At high tide, the wooden walkway was rolled up and stored on hotel porches. Around 1920, a permanent promenade was built. After being leveled by a storm in March, 1962, it was rebuilt to its present 2.9 mile length, ending at 27<sup>th</sup> St.  
The Downtown Association will be riding the boardwalk from 15<sup>th</sup> St. to Trimper's for the ending of our Progressive Dinner, Sunday, December 6<sup>th</sup>.
